*The introduction of the SCIP database, **Substances of Concern** in articles as such or in complex objects (**Products**), will support the implementation of the EU Action Plan for the Circular Economy.*

Based on the Waste Framework Directive 2008/98/EC, the SCIP database has been developed by ECHA. From January 5, 2021, companies placing articles containing substances on the Candidate List (SVHC - Substances of Very High Concern) on the EU market will be required to submit information on these articles to ECHA.

We provide you with comprehensive information on the legal requirements and laws that govern your reporting obligations to ECHA, so that you can avoid sanctions for non-compliance.
