The introduction of the SCIP Database, Substances of Concern In articles as such or in complex objects (Products) supports the implementation of the EU Action Plan for the circular economy.

Based on the Waste Framework Directive 2008/98/EC, ECHA established the SCIP Database. As of January 5, 2021, companies that produce, import or supply articles containing Candidate List substances (SVHC - Substances of Very High Concern) on the EU market have to submit information on these articles to ECHA.

We inform you in detail on the legal regulations and laws that determine your reporting obligations to ECHA so that you avoid penalties for non-compliance.
